Executive Order

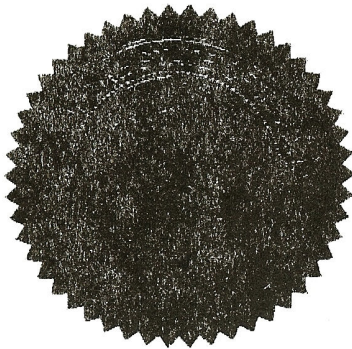
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETING:

- WHEREAS, alienating behaviors are often found in high conflict divorce and custody situations; and
- WHEREAS, these behaviors, can damage or destroy the bond between a loving parent and child; and
- WHEREAS, according to Indiana courts, in the year 2000, over 40,000 people in Indiana were divorced; and
- WHEREAS, with awareness comes education and understanding, and the power to stop the abuse of innocent children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim April 25, 2007 as

PARENTAL ALIENATION AWARENESS DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
