WHEREAS, we need your help to educate and to make the public aware of the effects of Parental Alienation and Hostile Aggressive Parenting; and

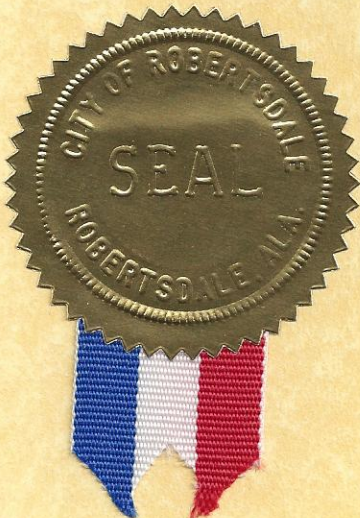


WHEREAS, with awareness come education and understanding, and the power to stop the abuse of innocent children caught in the crossfire of people they love; and
